



Kindergarten Prep Camp

Kindergarten is an exciting time of exploration for children. As their motor coordination increases, so too will their sense of independence, self reliance and self confidence. As the year progresses, they will be expected to complete assignments with less outside help, accept more responsibilities and follow rules more closely. Although the curriculum may vary from school to school, general goals focus on children building strong pre-reading skills. practicing letter formation, enhancing listening and communication skills, getting an introduction to basic math concepts and acquiring an active interest in the world. Our preschool summer program aims to prepare children (socially and academically) to enter Kindergarten.

The format follows the same weekly themes but the social and academic skills are more advanced. Students will work on handwriting, pre-reading/reading skills as well as math foundations. The children are assessed on the first day of camp and will be given a plan of action for the remainder of their time at camp.



First Grade Prep Camp

As students return to school this fall, many of them will be starting the academic year with achievement levels lower than where they were at the beginning of the summer break. This phenomenon is sometimes referred to as summer learning loss, summer setback or summer slide. Our camp is designed to combat the summer learning loss problem. This summer camp is for children who will be entering first grade in the fall. The goal of this summer camp is to help children reinforce the skills that they sometimes lose during the summer months. These skills include strengthening reading comprehension, continuing to practice writing (applying rules of mechanics as they write their own stories). practicing mathematics, enjoying the weekly theme activities and extending their independence and self-reliance. The children are assessed on the first day of camp and will be given a plan of action for the remainder of their time at camp.
